2023 Healthy Youth Survey coming Soon

Our schools will participate in the 2023 Healthy Youth Survey between October 16 – 25. Washington students in grades 6 through 12 take the survey every other year.

The Healthy Youth Survey asks questions about risks for unintentional and intentional injury, health outcomes, and alcohol and drug use. Survey results are used by schools, communities and state agencies to plan programs to support our youth and reduce their risks.

Participation in the survey is voluntary and the students' answers are anonymous.
