I want to thank all of you for assisting us in trying to get our Educational Programs & Operations Levy passed. Many of you are already aware that so far, we have missed passing the levy by 24 votes.

Here are the preliminary results:

Total votes cast: 790

Yes votes – 383 (48.48%)

No votes - 407 (51.52%)

We, as a district, want only the best for our students and strive every day to fulfill our district's mission of providing a quality education to all students in the community through programs of learning that emphasize basic education while challenging each student to build on natural abilities and develop skills to become life-long learners and productive, responsible citizens.

Quilcene School District appreciates the support our community provides for our children. The EP&O levy is needed to bridge the gap between basic education state and federal funding, and the cost of resources we need to provide a quality education for our students.
