As we prepare for a successful year ahead, we want to share some important updates regarding our school policies. These changes are designed to create a focused and secure learning environment for all students.

1. Cell Phone Policy:

In response to feedback from students, parents, and teachers, we have updated our cell phone policy to better support academic achievement and minimize distractions during school hours. Effective immediately:

- Cell phones must be turned off and away during instructional time.
- Students are permitted to use their phones before school, after school, during passing and breaks
- If a cell phone is seen or heard during instructional time without prior approval, we will use progressive discipline.

We believe this policy will help students stay more engaged and focused during their classes, and we appreciate your support in reinforcing this change at home.

2. Closed Campus:

To enhance student safety and ensure a secure learning environment, our campus will remain closed throughout the school day. This means:

- Students are required to stay on campus from the start of school until the end of the day.
- Visitors and parents must check in at the front office before entering any other areas of the school.
- High School students on the Honor Roll may apply for off campus privileges and follow the off campus rules by signing in and out of school.
